Ras Laffan Industrial City (RLIC), run and administered by Ras Laffan City (RLC), a directorate of Qatar Petroleum (QP), is a multipurpose, multidimensional industrial city, situated along the north east coast of Qatar. It is located about 80 kilometers from Qatar's North Field, which is the world's largest single non associated gas field with approximately 900 trillion cubic feet of proven reserves.

RLIC, destined to become the gas processing capital of the world, is one of the biggest producers of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG), Gas to Liquids Products (GTL), Sales Gas for Fuels, and ultimately petrochemicals such as ethylene, propylene, polyethylene and polypropylene. 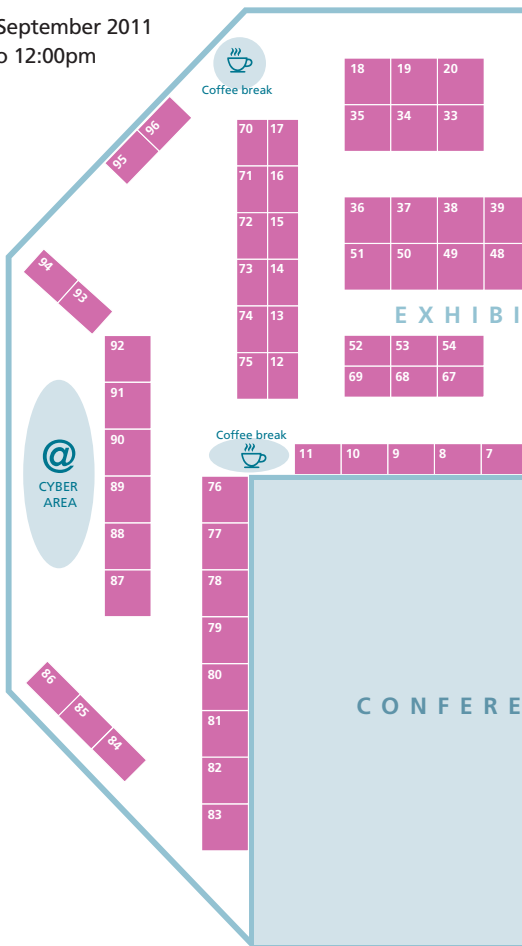

- 1 QAR = 0,2745 USD \$ 1 QAR = 0.1919 EUR€

## ■ ELECTRICITY

Electricity is 220-240v with a frequency of 50 Hertz.  
British standard plugs are used.

The code for dialing internationally from Qatar is 00.

## ■ TIPPING

A service charge of 10% is usually added to hotel and restaurant bills, in which case tipping is not necessary. However, if there is no service charge a 10% tip is appreciated. Taxi drivers do not expect a tip, but it is good to round off the amount due.

## ■ TIME

Local time is GMT +3.

## ■ WEATHER

Qatar enjoys sunshine just about everyday of the year.

Average temperature in September: 38°C to 42°C (day)/18°C (night).

Average humidity rate: 90%.
